He also answered many questions from the members present. Rob has been a great speaker and we enjoy having him come to our meetings.

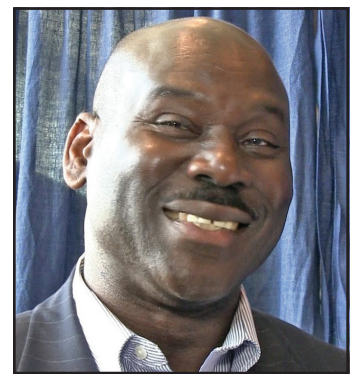
From the President




Our first Bunco of the off season is February 18, 2018. Please let Sue Farley know if you will be attending and how many so we can plan the food. Check out the attached flyer.

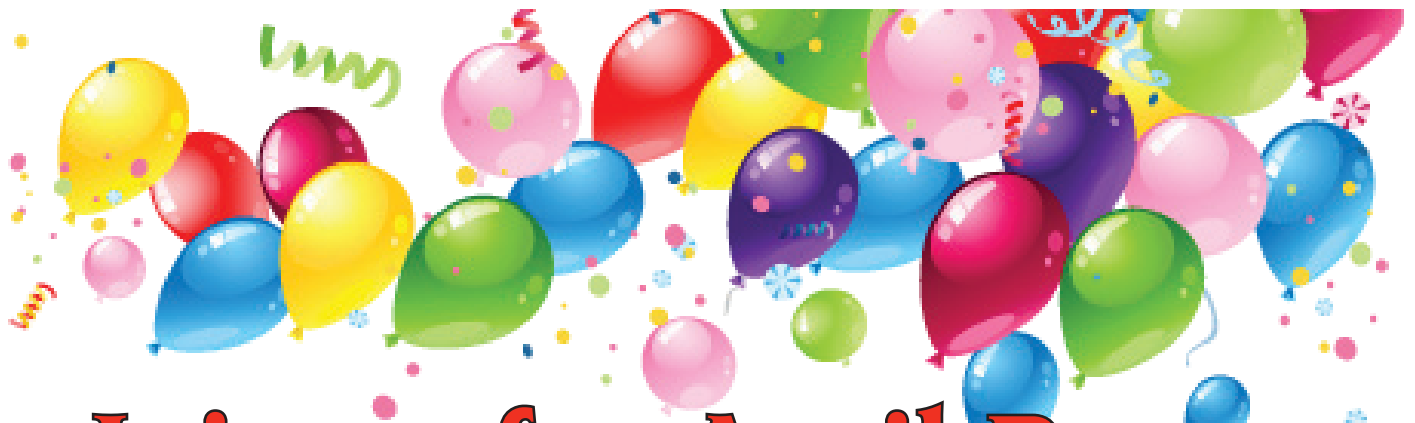

Social Media Content Priorities

July 2016 Central Council meeting minutes VP Publicity report. "Facebook posts – Assuring most of the posts are posts to Sea Hawker events / community projects / activities, so as not to overshadow them."

Absolutely, when information about Sea Hawker events/community projects/activities are known and available they will be the top priority. However, in the absence of having such information, the VPP will post relevant and positive items that inform and engage our members.

These priorities apply to Facebook, Instagram and Twitter.

Content Priorities

First – Sea Hawkers Central Council news and activities (ex: banquet, picnic, training camp, field passes, elections, Sea Hawker of the Year, Rookie of the Year, Fallen Sea Hawkers, membership drives etc.) AND Sea Hawker Satellite and Associate Satellite chapter events, fundraisers, community projects and activities.

Second – Seattle Seahawk team news, events and activities (ex: draft picks, player signings, family fest, 12's tour), current and former player events (ex: camps, fundraisers), and player news (ex: birthdays, babies and weddings). Countdowns to build momentum.

Third – Seattle Seahawk fan-base events and activities that are in good-standing with the team and would benefit our members knowing and participating (ex: Road Crew, Save Our Seahawks, etc.)

Content Guidelines

- Posts respect the Seahawks organization and Seahawks players, and are not disparaging.
 - Posts do not contain photos with nudity or anything of an explicit nature.
 - Posts or photos do not contain words such as f*ck, or other swear words.
- Posts are to reflect respect of other teams and their fans.

Goals

- Increase visibility for Sea Hawkers (council and chapters) among each other and to an external audience of non-members.
- Create a positive, welcoming environment that provides value to current members and supports recruitment of new members.
- Be viewed by members as a credible source for Sea Hawker and Seahawks news and used as a source of information/graphics that they can use in their own promotions.
- Nurture the Sea Hawkers relationship with the Seahawks by providing and promoting news, events and activities that are mutually beneficial.
