Ginger, the five-year-old German Shepherd mix, had an obstruction in her abdomen requiring surgery. The obstruction was a stick that had been in her abdomen for some time. The chance for a successful surgery outcome was about 50 percent. Since Ginger was only four years old, Friends at your Metro Animal Shelter (FAYMAS) decided to cover the expense. The operation was successful, she lived and was adopted by her Forever Family.

Friends at your Metro Animal Shelter (FAYMAS) is a non-profit established in 2014 to help animals at the Metro Animal Services Shelter located in Puyallup. This public shelter has limited funds, but serves Algona, Bonney Lake, Edgewood,

Milton, Pacific, Puyallup, and Sumner by providing animal control, licensing, adoption services and volunteer opportunities.

At our meeting May 21st, Bonnie King, President of FAYMAS will be sharing stories of animal lives impacted and projects on the horizon for this volunteer non-profit organization.


