Comments received after August 30, 2018 - may not be processed for this cycle of the annual ByLaw review. A copy of the ByLaws is available on the Sea Hawkers website, seahawkers.org, under booster club information.

During the month of September - Central Council will review and edit and a proposal to the ByLaws

based on input received in August. In October - Central Council will share a draft ByLaw document for general membership review. Comments will be evaluated and adjudicated. In November, Central Council will vote for acceptance of the revised ByLaws. At the December membership meeting - the Final ByLaws will be distributed.
