2022 KICKS4KIDS

Blitz has officially kicked off the 2022 Kicks4Kids “Good 4 The Sole Tour”! Sea Hawkers are very excited to partner with him again this year to raise money for kids in need of new shoes!

The Sea Hawkers have officially formed the Sea Hawker’s Kicks4Kids Committee of nine members (5 in WA and 4 outside WA). They’ve been working hard to outline the details of this year’s fundraising efforts! Please see below for important details.

DONATIONS

Donations can be made as a chapter or directly through the link below. Either way is fine!

IMPORTANT: Be sure that all donations to Kicks4Kids are made using this link, which is specific to the Sea Hawkers: <http://kicks4kids.tiny.us/SeaHawkers>

We will regularly report how much has been raised by chapter. Don’t forget to encourage members to ask their employers about corporate matching. This was very successful last year. You can begin raising money as early as you’d like. Funds raised through September 1, 2022, will count toward any chapter challenges.

Be sure to tell your friends and family to shop at Safeway (Washington only) on August 20 and donate at the pin pad! Note: These donations will not be trackable toward your chapter fundraising

CONTESTS AND DRAWING

Chapters who raise \$500+ will get one entry per \$500 to win a Blitz watch party! The chapter who raises the most will be presented with the Golden Shoe award at the 2023 banquet.

Between 8/21 – 9/1 we will be holding 12 daily drawings to win an autographed item donated by Blitz!

Drawing entries will be accepted outside of the Kicks4Kids website. Instead, entry to these drawings will be through a link posted on Sea Hawkers social media each day but will still count toward your chapter fundraising!

- Tickets will be \$5 each
- The drawings will be open from 8 am – 8 pm Pacific Time daily
- Only those who donate that day will be eligible for that day’s prize
- Donate every day to be eligible for all 12 prizes!
- Winners will be drawn (via Wheel of Names) at the end of the 12 days
- You do not have to be a member to participate

PINS

Blitz will be giving out new 2022 Kicks4Kids pins this year! The first 500 people to donate \$25+ and enter their chapter name via the website will receive a pin. One pin per person, regardless of donation amount. Pins will also be available at Training Camp (every day) and Touchdown City (August 18) while supplies last (\$25 donation each). Pins will be sent to chapter presidents for distribution (unless a donation is made at TC or TDC)

SHOE DISTRIBUTION

On September 6, Blitz will provide us with the total number of shoes the Sea Hawkers will receive. Once we have that number, the Kicks4Kids Committee will regroup and work through how to allocate the shoes to chapters as fairly as possible. We will then send an email out with how to submit your shoe requests. We highly recommend identifying a charity as early as possible!



KICKS4KIDS

Kicks 4 Kids is a charitable program started by the one and only best mascot in the NFL, Blitz, together with the Seahawks Women's Association!

All net proceeds will go directly to organizations and communities in the 12s community across the country to support kids and families in need.

This year

Blitz will rally his friends and family of 12s near and far to help reach his goal of donating 5,000 pairs of shoes.

In 2021, Blitz raised \$125,000 to buy shoes for youth around the Seattle area. Blitz delivered 2,200 pairs of shoes to 56 charities.


