

SEPTEMBER SPEAKER

Erika Thompson from the Wishing Well Foundation was the speaker for September. It is the only program set up in Pierce County to support foster children. The Wishing Well provides new and gently-used clothing and school supplies to children 0-18 years of age who are currently placed in the foster care system in Pierce County.

They are a nonprofit support agency focused on the well-being of abused and neglected youth within the foster care system. Their mission is to provide the clothing, supplies, and experiences unavailable to most foster kids and to retain quality foster homes in Pierce County by addressing financial barriers to accepting foster placements.

They also have Little Wishes which has grants to pay for sports, etc. They are open Wednesday and Sunday between 10 and 2.

They have a furniture bank for children who age out of the system that helps 20 families a month. The students graduating out also receive a basket of household items.

At Christmas they provide 700 toys and stockings. The main items they need are pajamas size 5 and up and jeans. They also could use volunteers for their events.
