Well, RWPA came through with 1044 pair of socks. Yes, I said 1044 pair of NIKE socks. So, the goal was met...but with being so close to 2000 I have decided to change the goal to 2000 pair of socks by Dec 31, 2017. I need to spend some time counting socks again, to get a current count... but I am guessing we are about 3-4 hundred pair away.

Social media is why SOLEMADE, out of Germany saw the flyer. I say we can all share the flyer via social media and ask our friends and family to do the same. How cool would it be to have 2000 pair of socks to distribute within our own community?
